# Taxpayer Funding of Abortion Takes Center Stage

Pennsylvania's longstanding ban on taxpayer funding of abortion took center stage at the PA Supreme Court recently.

A group of abortion facilities, led by an abortion center in Pittsburgh, has filed suit to demand a right to taxpayer funding of abortion under the PA Constitution.

If the High Court rules in favor of the abortion industry, it would be violating a 1985 precedent in which the Court declared there is no Constitutional right to taxpayer funding of abortion.

The abortion centers, led by Allegheny Reproductive Health Center, are claiming that the Medicaid abortion ban violates PA's Equal Rights Amendment, which states that a service cannot be denied on the basis of sex. But an attorney representing PA state Senators, Matthew Haverstick, stated, "This is not a case about the right to abortion in Pennsylvania. This is a funding case."

Currently, PA's Medicaid program pays for abortion only in the rare cases of rape, incest, and to save the life of the mother.

The PA Supreme Court is expected to issue its decision in the coming months.

Anticipating that the Court would go against precedent and rule in favor of the abortion industry, the state legislature earlier this year passed a Constitutional Amendment declaring no right to taxpayer funding of abortion under the PA Constitution.

PA Senate Bill 106 contained a Constitutional
Amendment declaring no state Constitutional right to abortion or taxpayer funding of it. The measure passed both the PA House and Senate. But a Constitutional Amendment must pass the state legislature in two consecutive sessions before it

can be placed on the ballot for voters to decide

Contrary to claims made by the abortion industry and its activists, the proposed amendment would not ban abortion. It would simply ensure that the people, through their duly elected representatives in the state legislature, can decide abortion policy, rather than a handful of largely unaccountable judges.

In a recent op-ed, the bill's sponsor, Republican state Senator Judy Ward, wrote:

"There have been claims that the amendment is an abortion ban. This is completely false. Unfortunately, the falsehoods don't stop there. Some have reported that if this amendment goes into effect, people's ability to use in vitro fertilization (IVF) treatments will be at risk. Others state that ectopic pregnancies will be forced to term regardless of if doing so would kill the mother, or that D&C procedures will be outlawed, forcing those who have miscarriages to risk serious

infection and disease. None of those statements are true.

"Here are the facts. Should the abortion provision of Senate Bill 106 be approved by the voters, Pennsylvanians will continue to have a statutory right to an abortion under Pennsylvania's Abortion Control Act.

"That Act would remain in place and unchanged. Medicaid will continue to cover both non-elective abortions and voluntary abortions involving cases of rape or incest but will still withhold funding for all other elective instances. IVF, ectopic pregnancies, and D&C procedures would be allowed under the same rules that exist today, and doctors will continue to save women's lives in the event of life-threatening complications during pregnancy."

Unfortunately, as of our printing deadline, it appears pro-abortion Democrats will soon have control of the PA House, meaning that it will be difficult to pass pro-life legislation this session. *Stay tuned for further developments*.

## LIFE in a Post-ROE World










't was a word of encouragement I repeated often — at chapter meetings, conventions, and banquets — trying to offer hope to not only the other people in the room, but to myself as well.

"Roe v. Wade will be overturned in our lifetime!" I would say, sometimes receiving skeptical responses in reply.

On June 24, 2022, that longago prediction came true. I was privileged to be at the National Right to Life Convention in Atlanta on that historic day when the U.S. Supreme Court tossed Roe into the dustbin of history. I ended up doing a Zoom interview with a television station within an hour of that incredible announcement.



I knew that, after *Roe's* reversal, life would never be the same.

In the months since the Supreme Court decision in Dobbs v. Jackson Women's **Health Organization**, I have been interviewed by news media at least twenty timesoften about the impact of the High Court ruling. News outlets ranging from Axios to Tokyo TV have sought insight and analysis from your donorsupported Pennsylvania Pro-Life Federation. Each media interview has provided an opportunity to educate members of the Fourth Estate about the promise and potential the Dobbs case offers.

### **What Dobbs Did**

**Dobbs** overturned both the 1973 U.S. Supreme Court decision known as Roe v. Wade and the 1992 ruling known as Planned Parenthood v. Casey.

In determining that there is no federal right to abortion under the U.S. Constitution, the Supreme Court returned the issue of abortion policy to the individual states, which can, in

turn, enact laws protecting preborn babies and their mothers from the harm of abortion.

Freed from the legal shackles imposed by Roe, the people, through their duly-elected representatives in state legislatures, can find creative ways to offer a lifeline to pregnant women and their children.

### **A Life-Saving Impact**

For decades, advocates for life have contended that overturning Roe would save lives. Now we have the empirical evidence to prove it.

A *New York Times* report confirmed a quick decline in abortion totals since the

Supreme Court ruling. Within just two months of the Dobbs decision, abortions plummeted six percent. In human terms, that meant more than 10,000 babies' lives saved.

- ▶ 10,000 children who will get to see the sunrise.
- ▶ 10,000 children who will have an opportunity to smile and laugh and play.
- ▶ 10,000 children who could grow up to discover cures for life-limiting conditions...to compose symphonies...to serve our nation and our communities in profoundly important ways.

#### **A Critical Cultural Shift**

The New York Times noted that, in the immediate aftermath of *Dobbs*, 13 states banned or notably restricted abortion. In those states (mostly in the South), legal abortions dropped close to zero, according to a group made up of both abortion providers and academics.

### **Pro-Abortion Backlash**

Meanwhile, the backlash to the *Dobbs* decision has been swift from the abortion industry and its allies. Abortion centers in Pennsylvania and other states have been working to expand abortion to out-ofstate customers. So much for the claim from some abortion advocates to make abortion "rare."

At the same time, money from abortion backers have been flooding campaigns to establish a so-called "right" to abortion—or defeat measures aimed at ensuring no "rights" to abortion--under state Constitutions. Such pro-abortion campaigns are filled with misrepresentations about the impact of protective pro-life laws on women and families.

### The End of the Beginning

It has been said that the overturn of *Roe* represents the end of the beginning of the pro-life movement. The victory at the U.S Supreme Court has been an important milestone on the road to achieving a restoration of rights for preborn Americans. Now, we must work doubly hard to ensure that the vision of an abortionfree country is realized.



Nine additional states enacted significant abortion restrictions, with legal abortions in those states declining by a third. All told, in light of the new legal landscape, 22,000 fewer abortions occurred more than offsetting the increase of 12,000 abortions in states that aggressively marketed abortion to out-of-state women.

It is indeed comforting to know that babies born today will be living in a post-Roe world. The greater respect for human life resulting from the Dobbs decision could have a ripple effect, helping to rebuild a culture of life in communities across the country.

### Strengthening the **Safety Net**

Pregnancy resource centers, maternity homes, and adoption agencies have knitted

when a pregnant woman is facing a crisis. With an outpouring of compassion and support, these heroic individuals are assisting women and their families each day in a non-judgmental, affirming atmosphere.

### **The Pennsylvania Perspective**

Stories of triumph over trauma abounded at a recent gathering in south central Pennsylvania.

The participants came together to discuss the Keystone State's phenomenal **Pregnancy and Parenting** Support Services program, which is administered by Real Alternatives, Inc.

Two pro-life powerhouse lawmakers, State Senator Judy Ward and State Representative Dawn Keefer, moderated the event.

The first panel dealt with the overall impact of the 27year-old program, which offers services to pregnant women and to their families up to 12

TryLife Center in Lower Burrell explained how the program not only saves lives, but changes lives.

Real Alternatives President and CEO Kevin Bagatta noted that "over 340,000 women have been served, not counting the babies, at 1.9 million visits." As Senator Ward said, the program "strengthens women and that's what I love about it!"

The second panel, made up of program counselors, explored the unique issues facing pregnant women in challenging circumstances and the comprehensive support they receive from social service agencies, pregnancy support centers, and maternity homes.

"To be able to go into a place where somebody is just listening to them and not casting judgment is just enormous" for the women experiencing an unexpected pregnancy, said Rep. Keefer.

The third panel discussed service providers who separately offer medical services to women, such as ultrasounds

reetings, distinguished \_members of the Pennsylvania Pro-Life Federation! I am excited to start as your Executive Director and General Counsel on January 1, 2023. I would like to take this opportunity to introduce myself and my vision for the Federation.

It is an exciting as well as challenging time for our prolife mission here in Pennsylvania as well as nationwide. I am ready to meet these challenges.

As I stated during my official introduction at our extraordinarily successful Banquet, I have heard the cries of the voiceless my entire life. I was born two years before Roe was decided. Its aftermath profoundly affected my life and obviously those of successive generations. Dr. Ben Carson and I share at least one thing in common - dedicated mothers who instilled in us a love for truth and hard work. As the youngest of five in an Italian Catholic family, I was regularly involved in conversations about cultural issues like abortion. These discussions as well as growing up in a family that weathered formidable challenges taught me the value of staying true to your principles in times of adversity.

My early pro-life awareness centrally influenced my educational development. In learning about the great political heritage of our country, I

could never understand why the same Constitution that protected our most vulnera-

ble and downtrodden citizens did not also protect the unborn. My intellectual

quandary led to a deep, heartfelt conviction that abortion is a great evil against which we must compassionately fight. This conviction led me to study at The Catholic University of America (where I annually witnessed the March for Life), the University of Wisconsin (where I listened to a talk given by Sarah Weddington, the lawyer who represented "Jane Roe") and finally Yale Law School, where I wrote a major research paper on genetic screening and partial birth abortion.

As a practicing "Philadelphia Lawyer" for the past two decades, I have been extensively involved with prolife education and child advocacy. I served as a volunteer speaker for Pennsylvanians for Human Life (a Federation associate) for 15 years. I used my legal background to trace the genesis of Roe and its legal, ethical and cultural ramifications in schools throughout the Delaware Valley. I was honored to serve as the President of PHL for the past decade.

I learned the intricacies of nonprofit dynamics, fundraising and building coalitions across kindred organizations. Most importantly, I learned the value of calm yet strong leadership in navigating the stormy seas generated by the pro-life mission while preserving the institutional integrity of that mission.

I am prepared to bring this leadership to the Federation. I inherit the

> Federation's formidable legislative influence at a crossroads in

our nation's history. The Dobbs decision was seismic. We all should take just pride in the long, hard work resulting in the Supreme Court's extinction of a "fundamental" constitutional right to abortion. the then-pending *Dobbs* decision. In October we welcomed the chance to meet new students and answer questions about a post-*Roe* America.

Two other events took us to York. The *reorganization meeting for our York chapter* and the *Kick Off Rally for 40 Days for Life*, both of which were well attended, included both newcomers and seasoned pro-lifers.

Executive Director

Michael Ciccocioppo had the privilege of speaking to seminarians who are in formation to be ordained priests at

Mount St. Mary's University.

His presentation centered on creating vibrant pro-life parishes post-Roe.

Just days before our Celebrate Life Banquet, we participated in a school-wide assembly at Bishop McDevitt

Roe's overturn last June was a victory that every pro-life advocate welcomed and celebrated. But it also spurred abortion supporters to ramp up their false narratives. Distortions, half-truths, and outright lies proliferated through mainstream and social media, leaving many confused.

The best way to combat misinformation is **education**, of course! For the last few months Federation staff have been traveling **throughout the Commonwealth and beyond** to convey facts about abortion and speak truth about the rising number of pro-life protections enacted across the country.

We were invited to two mid-state parishes, *St. Margaret Mary Alacoque* 

and *Holy Name of Jesus*, to discuss the role of the Church in the post-Roe era.
Many were

surprised to learn of former abortionist-turned-pro-life activist Dr. Bernard
Nathanson's revelation that the Catholic Church was the target of a propaganda campaign in the early 1970s. In addition to setting the record straight on what the *Dobbs* decision did and did not do, information on helping women through church ministries and pregnancy resource centers was presented.

In September, we were invited to speak to students enrolled in a *Public Policy course at Gettysburg College*. Students submitted ques-

tions to their professor who then curated them and passed them on to us. Legislative

*High School* in Harrisburg. Again, students submitted questions that were curated and organized into categories. While I addressed questions on abortion statistics, reasons why abortion is sought, and how it hurts women, other panelists, including a pro-life OB/GYN, a male nurse from a pregnancy resource center, and the school chaplain, responded to questions relevant to their expertise. Students had the chance to ask follow-up questions in a live Q and A.

At several of these talks we were able to provide an education display that included fetal models and a plethora of pro-life literature, making sure accurate information is available. We also staffed education displays at several other events, including the *Creation Music Festival* in Shirleysburg and *Stewardship Conference* in Elizabethtown.

We look forward to several more presentations in the coming weeks and months. We welcome every opportunity to challenge the misinformation circulated by the abortion industry and to arm pro-lifers with facts.

### **An Incredible Night Celebrating Life**

His is a true rags-to-riches story. An American dream realized.

He's brilliant. Charming. Accomplished. Funny.

But most importantly, he is a fierce and unapologetic defender of all human life, from womb to tomb.

From the moment we announced Dr. Ben Carson as our Keynote Speaker for the 2022 Celebrate Life Banquet, there was a tremendously enthusiastic response. We sold every one of the 1200 seats at the Hershey Lodge, almost dou-

dose of much needed common sense. And he did so with civility, humility, and humor.

Dr. Carson began his talk with a disclaimer, warning that he is not politically cor-

He shared that from the time he was a young child he always wanted to get into medicine, even relishing visits to the doctor's office. But because he was a poor student, medicine didn't seem a likely path. That is, until his mother intervened.

"The only one who really believed in me was my mother...My mother had less than a 3rd grade education, but she was the wisest person I've ever known."

Working as a domestic in wealthy homes, she gleaned that reading and education were the path to success. She turned off the TV and implemented a consistent reading routine into her

corners of the state to attend our first post-Roe banquet and to hear the pediatric brain surgeon, former presidential candidate, and retired Secretary of Housing and Urban Development, deliver what has become his signature prescription: a

effect on young Ben, changing the trajectory of his life.

In a short time he went from the bottom of his class to the top, realizing that "the person that has the most to do with what happens in your life is you."



Having lived in liberal cities his whole life, from Detroit to Boston to Baltimore, Dr. Carson admitted to having been a liberal himself, even on the issue of abortion. While his Christian upbringing told him that abortion was wrong, he felt he could not tell others what to do.

But his position changed when he dove deeply into studying slavery. He saw parallels to the abortion issue, noting that slave owners thought they owned the slaves and could do whatever they wanted to them. What if he applied his own abor-

> tion ethic to the issue of slavery?

"What if the abolitionist had said I don't believe in slavery but you do what you want to

do...where would we be now as a nation?"

Being personally opposed to abortion but claiming it as a right that others should have was no longer a position that Dr. Carson could hold. Citing a passage from


Proverbs, he firmly believes we all have a responsibility to help those who cannot help themselves.

Dr. Carson implored everyone to "think about the sacredness of life" while explaining that from the moment of conception there is a distinct individual separate from the mother. In just 6-8 weeks, little arms, legs, facial features, and a beating heart are all present, he said.

At this young embryonic stage, this little human is highly complex, more sophisticated than a snail darter, an endangered freshwater fish. Dr. Carson noted that environmentalists make more efforts to save the snail darter than they do to save human babies that are made in the image of God.

"Have you ever seen an abortion?" he asked. He went on to explain matter-of-factly the reality of abortion. He said that in first trimester abortions ultrasound imaging shows babies moving away from the invasive tube that is placed in the womb to claim their lives.

He then graphically described second trimester abortions in which forceps are used to twist, turn, and



pull out limbs and other body parts, calling it "barbaric."

"I personally do not understand how people in the medical profession can actually do that. I can't understand it. Are we any better than ancient civilizations?"

During his long and successful medical career, Dr. Carson not only operated on children outside the womb, but also those patients still in the womb.

He recounted the story of a woman who was pregnant with twins. One twin suffered from severe hydrocephalus, a condition where excess fluid builds up in the brain. This condition was a threat to both babies as it could have triggered premature labor well

before the twins were viable.

Aware that intrauterine surgery was being done experimentally on animals, Dr. Carson thought the same principles could be applied to surgery on pre-born humans. He then pioneered the operation that reduced

fluid in the baby's head, allowing both babies to remain in utero several more weeks until their lungs matured. When the twins were finally delivered, both were healthy and ultimately thrived.

In another instance, Dr. Carson met a woman determined to get an abortion at 33 weeks

because her child had been diagnosed with a neurological condition. He convinced her to not get the abortion and to allow him to operate on the baby in utero. The procedure was successful, and today she loves that child so much and is so glad she didn't get that abortion.

"No one will ever convince me that what's in a woman's womb is a meaningless bunch of cells."

While recognizing that the Dobbs decision was a critical victory, Dr. Carson noted, "The reversal of Roe v. Wade is not the end but the beginning of what needs to be done."

He encouraged pro-lifers to work harder than ever before. He said women need

Dr. Carson said we have a responsibility to provide care for anyone that is helpless and vulnerable, including the mentally ill, the homeless, and those addicted to drugs.

"We are talking about human beings made in the image of God... We don't have to accept every activity, every behavior, but we do have to accept all people and love them."

We've migrated much of the information that was on the old website, but have organized it so that visitors can find information easily. We're also continuing to add new content reflecting the post-Roe era. ### **PA March for Life**

C taff from the Federation attended the **2nd Annual Pennsylvania March for Life** in September, distributing hundreds of pro-life signs to attendees. Former Celebrate Life Keynote Speaker, author and producer *Ann McElhinney* gave a rousing speech on the travesty and tragedy of Kermit Gosnell. Executive Director *Michael Ciccocioppo* was interviewed by Fr. Frank Pavone of Priests for Life.

Over 5000 people from all over the Commonwealth marched. In contrast, less than 100 showed up for the proabortion rally the next day. That means pro-lifers outnumbered pro-abortion advocates by 500 to 1!

### **Wanted: Youth Voices for Life!**

Each spring we offer students two ways to become life advocates: through our essay contest and our speech contest. Students from all over the state in public, private, parochial, or homeschool classrooms are eligible. These contest are not only a rich opportunity to learn, but an exercise that will prepare young people to intelligently discuss important societal issues and defend innocent life.

Our essay contest is open to students in grades 7-12. Judging is divided into two divisions, junior 7th-9th grades and senior 10th -12th grades. Students can choose to write on any prolife topic having to do with abortion, infanticide, euthanasia, doctor-prescribed suicide, or stemcell research. The top three winners in each division receive recognition and a cash prize. In addition, firstplace essays in each division are published in the Summer edition of LifeLines.

The Speech Contest is open to 9th-10th grade students (novice division) and 11th-12th (senior division). Students write an original speech on a prolife topic and record themselves delivering

that speech. Students can submit their speeches through a digital platform or by flashdrive. Winners in both novice and senior categories are awarded recognition and a cash prize, with the first place winner in the senior division winning an all-expense paid trip to compete in the Oratory Contest at the National Right to Life Convention, which will be held in Pittsburgh, PA this year.


