DID YOU KNOW?

Nearly 1,800 black babies are aborted every day in the U.S.⁽¹⁾

African-Americans make up about ten percent of Pennsylvania’s population, yet black women account for **38 percent of abortions** in the state.⁽²⁾

Since 1973, **more than twice** as many blacks have died from abortion than from heart disease, cancer, accidents, violent crimes, and AIDS **combined**.⁽³⁾

Over 20 million African-American children have died since Roe v. Wade made abortion legal for any reason throughout all nine months of pregnancy.⁽⁴⁾

Black women are **more than three times** as likely as white women to have an abortion.⁽⁵⁾

In Philadelphia, **nearly 14,000 black children** were aborted in just one year.⁽⁶⁾
