2022 ABORTION STATISTICS Executive Summary

Pennsylvania has been monitoring and reporting on abortion data since 1975. This report is produced pursuant to Section 3214 of the Abortion Control Act, 18 Pa. C.S. § 3214(e)(1).

In 2022, there were 34,838 abortions performed in Pennsylvania. Nearly half, (16,065) of all abortions performed in Pennsylvania were to white individuals, and 14,923 were to Black or African-American individuals. Abortions to individuals of Hispanic origin accounted for 4,297, or 12.4 percent, of all abortions in 2022. More than 88 percent (30,405) of the abortions performed in Pennsylvania in 2022 were to unmarried individuals.

The largest age group having abortions was 25-29, accounting for 10,107 (29.0 percent) of all 2022 abortions. Individuals under age 20 accounted for 8.0 percent of all abortions in 2022, and individuals under age 18 accounted for 2.2 percent. Comparatively, in 2021, individuals under age 20 accounted for 7.7 percent, and individuals under age 18 accounted for 2.1 percent.

Similar to 2021, 90.5 percent of the abortions performed in 2022 were on Pennsylvania residents. Residents of other states, territories and other countries accounted for just 3,311 abortions in 2022.

Of the abortions performed in 2022 in Pennsylvania, 95.5 percent were performed in ten counties: Allegheny; Berks; Bucks; Dauphin; Delaware; Lehigh; Montgomery; Northampton; Philadelphia; and York.

More than 33 percent of Pennsylvania residents having abortions were residents of Philadelphia County. Other counties that account for a greater percentage of resident abortions included: Allegheny (3,583); Montgomery (2,047); Delaware (1,819); Lehigh (1,292); Bucks (1,134); and Dauphin (1,022). Of all 67 counties, 24 (35.8 percent) showed a decrease in the number of resident abortions performed in 2022 compared to 2021.

In 2022, there were 469 reports of complications from abortions that were submitted by physicians; 45.6 percent more than the 322 reported in 2021. More than 75 percent of the complications were related to retained products of conception, 14.7 percent to bleeding and 3.6 percent to infection.

Unknowns are excluded from all calculations.

Notes: The source for the number of abortions reported in Pennsylvania in 2022 is the "Report of Induced Termination of Pregnancy," which is an individual report filed for each procedure. The source for the complications data is "Abortions: Report of Complications," a separate reporting form completed by physicians who have provided medical care to an individual because of a complication resulting from an abortion or attempted abortion.
