# New Legislation Threatens Innocent Human Life

# Life at the Capitol

A tidal wave of anti-life legislation is swamping the state Capitol, raising the prospects of new threats against the most vulnerable among us.

It seems that every week our Legislative Associate **Debbie Heisey** emails me with an alert about another bad bill that has been introduced in the Pennsylvania General Assembly.

**The good news?** We can stop this legislative tsunami before it reaches the Governor's desk. But we must all do what we can, through peaceful, educational means, to stop these potential public policy disasters.

## Undermining Protections for Mother and Child

The so-called *Reproductive Freedom Act* is an example of a bill that would *undermine* fundamental protections in Pennsylvania law for both mother and child. House Bill 26, sponsored by state Representative **Kristine Howard** (D-Chester County), aims to dismantle our time-tested Abortion Control Act.

The *Abortion Control Act* passed the state legislature and was signed into law in 1989, but it did not go into effect until the mid-1990s because of court challenges. The law served as the basis of the landmark 1992 U.S. Supreme Court ruling known as *Planned Parenthood v. Casey*.

The *Abortion Control Act* is a visionary piece of legislation which ensures a number of protections for pregnant moms and the babies they hold in their wombs. These include:

- **Parental consent**, meaning a parent must provide permission before a minor girl can get an abortion;
- **Informed consent**, meaning a woman must be told the risks of abor-

tion and alternatives to abortion, prior to an abortion taking place;

- **A 24-hour waiting period** for abortion, allowing a grace period in which a woman can reflect on the life-or-death decision of abortion and consult with the father of the child, her parents, members of the clergy, and other individuals in her inner circle.

When the *Abortion Control Act* went into effect, abortion totals in Pennsylvania decreased dramatically. In fact, statistics from the PA Department of Health show that they were cut in half. This demonstrates the effectiveness of the law in safeguarding women and children from the tragic harm of abortion.

The *Abortion Control Act* represents common sense public policy, and it should not be discarded in the interests of furthering the agenda of the lucrative abortion industry.

## Other Dangers to Pregnant Moms and Babies

Pro-abortion lawmakers have also signaled their intentions to pursue legislation which would further endanger pregnant moms and their babies. These include:

- **a proposed Constitutional Amendment which would make abortion a fundamental right under the PA Constitution;**
- **a measure to allow non-physicians to perform abortions;**
- **efforts to regulate pro-life pregnancy resource centers out of existence.**

*It would appear that the abortion lobby has hijacked the leadership of the PA House of Representatives*, creating a situation in which women and children are under greater threat than they have been in years. A one-vote Democrat majority in the PA House means that pro-abortion legislation could get a hearing and could ultimately make it onto the House floor for a vote.

## Threats to People with Disabilities

Meanwhile, the pro-euthanasia lobby is taking aim at our long-standing protections against assisted suicide in the Commonwealth. House Bill 1109, sponsored by state Representative **Carol Hill-Evans** (D-York County), would strike down our state ban on assisted suicide.

The bill would permit the distribution of lethal drugs to cause the death of an individual. The measure would even allow non-doctors to prescribe the pills intended to kill.

Laws permitting assisted suicide are particularly dangerous for people with disabilities, who may be most susceptible to being denied the health care they need. Individuals suffering from depression may also be especially vulnerable where assisted suicide is legalized.

The so-called "right to die" can easily turn into the "duty to die," causing individuals to die before their time.

The bill goes by the incredibly deceptive title of "*Compassionate Aid in Dying*." But there is nothing compassionate about pressuring an individual to commit suicide. And there is nothing caring about killing.

## What You Can Do to Prevent the Legislative Assault on Life

Here are a few simple things you can do to prevent the legislative assault on life:

- ✓ **Call and email your state representative and let him or her know you oppose these anti-life bills, and you want them to do the same;**
- ✓ **Make an appointment with your state representative, visit his or her office, and speak to your lawmaker in person about the dangerous aspects of these bills;**
- ✓ **WRITE A LETTER to the editor of your local newspaper opposing these measures;**

✓ **Demonstrate your support for life on social media.** Post *Ultrasound pictures of babies in their mothers' wombs.* Cite stories about the miraculous survival of premature infants. Celebrate the babies in your life!

By following these steps, you can help stop anti-life legislation in its tracks.

**T**here are over 8 billion people on the planet. Every single one of them was born of a woman. That's an incredible fact of life — a testament to the generosity of mothers who gave birth under incredibly challenging circumstances across generations. Women were made for this. They were designed — biologically and emotionally — to become mothers.

As a first-time mom, I am overwhelmed by the celebration of a woman's body and its capacity to grow life that I see in pregnancy support groups and across social media. I can't seem to escape the algorithms filling my feed with tips for a smoother labor, postpartum care, breastfeeding advice, and healthy pregnancy habits. Working moms, teen moms, stay-at-home moms — so many women have embraced their calling to be mothers and are thriving in it.

It saddens me that this reverence for new life is not shared by all — that the idea of cherishing and celebrating life, however small or developing, is often dismissed.

At a recent event where I was tabling, my husband Alex was helping me set up. As I laid out the fetal models we always display, he looked at them curiously and asked to see the one

that shows how far along we are. I held up the 24-week baby — a fully formed, one-pound human. "If only people knew," he said.

Sometimes I wonder — if abortion had never been introduced as an option, would

women have conceived of it on their own? Especially when every part of their body is physiologically prepared to protect and nourish the child from the moment of conception? Abortion divides a woman's heart, mind, and body. It interrupts a natural, sacred process — regardless of the stage of development.

When I place my hand on my belly, I imagine my little boy reaching back through the thin layers of skin and tissue that separate us. Even though I can't always feel him, see him, or experience him fully, there's



no denying he is real and alive. Today, technology allows us to witness this miracle — through ultrasounds — as early as six weeks, offering proof beyond speculation.

And yet, I recognize that **maternal ambivalence is real**. Many women struggle with the idea of motherhood - often caught up in the whirlwind of their circumstances or past experiences. Pregnancy can sometimes be a physically demanding, and always a life-altering journey — one no woman should walk alone. That's where I see the pro-life movement stepping in: to affirm her strength, to not only celebrate her ability to be radically generous with her body but to support her and empower her to be her fullest self.

# A Pro-Lifer's Tale

## on Plane Rides and Babies.

“**T**hud,” I jerk back in my seat as I grudgingly wake up.

Something hit me.

“Oow.” I say softly while rubbing my head to not disturb the people sitting next to me. I look to my left and my right.

“No... he's sleeping and she's playing Sudoku. Who hit me then?” I say to myself. Now I'd like to imagine I'm this virtuous guy with a proper sense of patience in moments like these, but I'm not. I was already mad that my early morning flight had been delayed, and now I had just been woken up from my nap that was supposed to let me catch up on the plentiful amount of sleep I missed due to the flight.

*I hear a little giggle from in front of me, followed by cute little eyes popping up in between the two seats in front of me. It was a baby.*

**My outlook immediately changed.** I was no longer mad, annoyed, or frustrated about my head or the plane delay. I was pleasantly surprised at how easily and flawlessly the baby lifted my mood. Sure I was still sleep deprived, but the baby kept looking at me while giggling and I couldn't help but smile. She took my attention away from my lack of sleep and I ended up playing peek-a-boo with her until her parents woke up and repositioned her.

“Wow. What just happened?”

Reality just slapped me across the face, and I deserved it. I started my day by waking up super early, constantly complaining to those around me about things I couldn't control, was not myself getting on the plane, and when I awoke from my nap, the first thing I did was look for someone to blame. And that someone was a 1-year-old baby.

**After realizing how inconsiderate I had been, I stopped myself, said a short prayer asking for help to recenter myself, and took a deep breath.** I cannot change the past, but I can do my best in the present and look forward to the future. So, having a surmountable time left on the plane ride and an attitude to be productive and positive, I took out my iPad which had a sticky note of what I could do to pass time on the plane ride. 



